COMMON Humane-Washing TERMS

Misleading & deceitful public relations & advertising fabrications.

- **Cage-free eggs** Thousands of chickens, turkeys crowded inside windowless, industrial sheds. Poorly ventilated, feces laden. Workers may wear HazMat suits and breathing masks but the chickens don't.
 - Cruelty-free NO USDA MEANING*



- Ethically Sourced, Ethically Raised NO USDA MEANING*
- Family farm Implies small; giants like Perdue, Tyson are "family farms."
- Farm Implies small, but industrial factories can/do call themselves "farms."
- **Free-range chickens** USDA *requires only access* to outdoor area, e.g., small door in giant shed, but no specified size, quality of area, or amount of time in it.
- Grass-fed, grass-finished more grass in cow's diet = more methane emitted.
- Happy cows, pigs, hens, etc. can be beaten, abused. NO USDA MEANING*
- **Humane Certified** SOME USDA MEANING, BUT FEW INSPECTIONS, LAX ENFORCEMENT, MINOR PENALTIES (Any costs are passed on to consumers.)
- Natural Comes from nature, e.g., unrefined crude oil. NO USDA MEANING*
- **Organic** No pesticides in feed or post-slaughter processing, but the same brutal, short life. (Cutting off pig/cow testicles, horns, tails; debeaking chickens all w/o anesthetic. No antibiotics for sick, suffering animals. No less cruelty.
- **Pasture-raised** outdoor *access*, but not necessarily more (or any) outdoor time. Same brutalities of confinement, mutilations, babies taken, early deaths.
- Raised with Care/Love NO USDA MEANING*
- Regenerative Cattle Ranching, Holistic Management, Rotational Grazing cows moved around larger areas. Worse environmental impacts. Not scalable. More land and water pollution by manure, more methane air pollution. NO USDA MEANING*
- Restorative NO USDA MEANING*
- Sustainable NO USDA MEANING*
